

## DRIVING FROM ROME TO BELLAUGELLO

Leave Rome Centre, or Ciampino, or Fiumicino Airports and head for the **Grande Raccordo Anulare**. Exit the GAR at the north on the **A1** direction **Florence**. The first section is free, but at Roma Nord it becomes a toll road.

Continue for about 40km and exit at **Orte** to take the **E45** for **Perugia**. Continue north for about 90km. Near Perugia, you must keep on the same road and head for **Cesena**.

After a further 12 km beyond Perugia, leave the E45 at the Bosco exit and take the **SS 298** to **Gubbio**. Keep on for another 20km. You will pass through Colombella and Farnetto and climb out of the Tiber valley, passing by Piccione and through Casacce, Belvedere and Scritto.

Some 3km after Scritto, there's a restaurant on the left, "Il Panaro". The turning for **Valdichiascio** is 1km further on on the **right**, opposite a large stone wall. If you start going downhill on the main road, you have gone too far.

In Valdichiascio, stay on the asphalt road downhill for 3km. Pass by a large house on the left, "Il Gabbiano", and a house very close to the road on the right. At the yellow house, take **the left fork**. You'll notice the road becomes a *strada bianca* (a dirt road). After 200m, take the next **left**, a sharp curve, and Bellaugello is the first house on the **right**, in all 4km from the main road. There are signs for Bellaugello in Valdichiascio.
